The check for \$10,000 from the Genz Small Business Development Fund was issued to Owners Susan Hanley and Carrie Clark of Elizabeth, Illinois the evening of July 31, 2024. It's the fund's largest award to date.

According to Hanley and Clark, the money was used to turn a storage room into an evening lounge space with a new custom-built bar, six gaming machines, television, tables and décor. It leverages Lola's new dinner menu of entrees and appetizers and offers beer, wine, plus signature drinks including their 'Elizabeth Sky' cocktail. On hand to congratulate Hanley and Clark was a group of friends and family, along with the NWILED Board, Elizabeth Area Chamber of Commerce, and Elizabeth's Mayor Thomasson.

"This was Lola's Deli second Genz Fund award," said David Schmit, NWILED Regional Director. "We first assisted Susan and Carrie back in 2020 and 2021 when they wanted to turn the old Welcome Inn into Lola's Deli. The Village of Elizabeth, Jo Daviess County, and NWILED came together to help make that happen. Now three years later we are excited to see Lola's take their next big step. The lounge has a fantastic feel to it, and I encourage people to check it out."

Established in 2020, the Genz Small Business Development Fund was formed by the late John "Jack" Genz of Galena to help retailers, small manufacturers, wholesalers and hospitality industry genres, along with farmers and food processors and can be used to help fund capital projects, to purchase an existing business or for startup and pilot projects. The fund is administered by Illinois Bank & Trust. Since first awarded in 2020 a total of \$53,302 has now been dispersed through the fund.
